Learning – Scouts learn to use tools by participating in the cubmobile construction.

Creativity – Scouts decorate their cubmobile and costumes based on the annual theme.

Competition – Scouts learn sportsmanship by experience regardless of who wins.

Courage – Fear of losing and fear of crashing must both be overcome by every scout.
